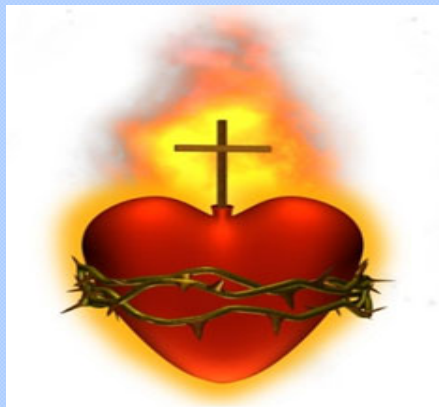

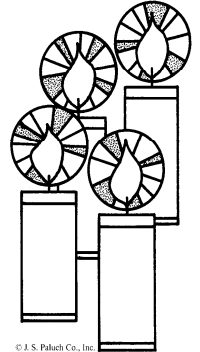

YARD SALE IN DUDLEY

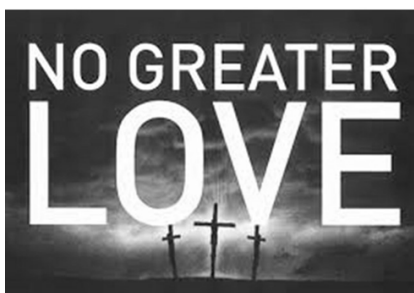
