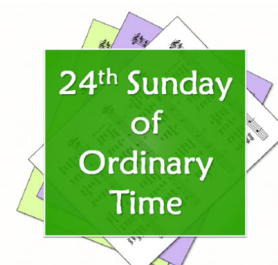
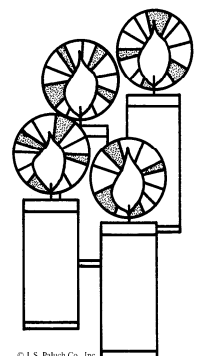

**CATHOLIC MEN'S GROUP MEETINGS**

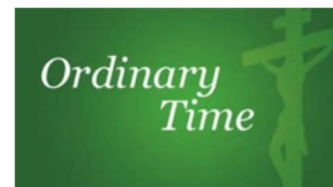
